Vice Mayor Justin Addington called the special called meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. The purpose of the meeting was the **Public Hearing on the Proposed FY2022-2023 Budget**.

Public Comment: None

Council Comment: Council member Robert Hammonds asked if a decision has been made by Scott County officials whether to use the new 2022 Tax Assessment numbers or the ones from 2021. The County has re-opened the ability for citizens to appeal their Tax Assessment totals. If the 2021 totals are used, it will result in a significant change in the proposed Property Tax Income. And the Budget for FY2022-2023 will be directly affected. Mike Carrico, Town Attorney stated, that if that happens, funds can be moved from other General Ledgers within the Town's Budget to cover any short falls encountered if the projected income falls below Budget projections.
